1. Lazy Daisy Stitch
Single motif: Leaf, Flower
bud, Decorative accent,
Teardrop earring
Multiple stitches: Bows,
Flowers



2. **Stardust Stitch**Starry night sky: #060
for dark sky (diagonal stitches), #101, 032, or 001
for stars (tent stitches)




3. Couching
Traditional, in-line and
coiled: Couch the Canvas
(#24) braid into place with
the same color Very Fine
(#4) Braid. Curved lines,
Straight lines, Letters,
Numbers, Outlining,
Circular motifs



4. **Double Straight Cross** Single motif: Star (001,


001HL, 002, 002HL, 002V, 032 101, 202HL). Stitch pattern: Filigree, crowns, 001, 001HL, 002, 002HL, 002V, 101, 202HL



5. **Rococo**Single motif: Ornament, light, jewelry, bow center



6. Woven Picot Insect Wings 032, Angel Wings 001, 002, 002HL, 002V, 032, 202HL, Leaves



7. **Woven Spider Stitch**Bows, Flowers, Ornaments,
Jewelry, Wheels, Round
holiday candy



2-Color Octagonal Rhodes StitchOrnaments, Holly berries,
Pom poms, Door knob,
Jewelry, Round windows


8. Octagonal Rhodes or



9. **Twisted cord**Stems, Borders,
Garland, Numbers, Sleigh
runners, rope or reins, Dog
leash or collar, Broom
handle. Decorative trim for
finishing




10. **T Stitch**Backgrounds,
Wallpaper pattern, Tablecloths, Lace, Curtains,
Angel wings, Eyeglass
lenses, Window panes



11. **Darning patterns**Backgrounds, Snow, Sky,
Water



12. Tassel



13. Padded Rice Stitch Use Canvas (#24) braid for the long padding stitches; Borders, Stripes, Stocking cuffs, Fancy baskets



14. **Trellis Couching**Use Canvas (#24) braid for the grid; Background,
Clothing, Baskets, Lattice,
Christmas packages,
Borders



5. Buttonhole stitch on an O-ring

Work buttonhole stitch around the O-ring and then attach to the canvas; Wheel, Wreath (continue around the detached buttonhole stitch), Door knocker



16. Tied Double Cross Stitch


Stars, Spoked wheels, Windows, Jewels, Large snowflakes, Lacy clothing



17. **Daisy** Stars, Jewelry, Flowers, Eyes




18. **Visible Appliqué**Use Canvas (#24) braid to attach the appliqué to the stitched piece.



19. **Upright Oriental Stitch** Water, Sky, Background



20. Long-armed Cross stitch Braid, Borders, Epaulets, Handles



21. Combine with The real metal thread Jaceron
Wind the Canvas (#24) braid inside a stretched length of Jaceron and attach to canvas with plunged ends of the braid; Flower stems, Bird legs, Eyeglasses, Borders, Decorative accents



22. Horizontal Elongated Smyrna Cross
Belt buckles, Shoe buckles, Jewelry



23. **Herringbone Stitch** Borders, Stripes, Flower stems



24. **Ruching**Pull a single ply from
a cut length of braid to
gather, couch on canvas
into desired shape.
