

Stitch Guide for Quilt Block Menorah GS116- Kreinik version

General Directions:

This Guide includes a "Road Map" of your canvas, identifying each area to be stitched. The thread, number of strands and stitch used are listed, as well as a diagram. Remember, when more than one strand is used in your needle, you need to lay the threads flat with your laying tool. You should also use your laying tool when stitching with multiple strands (such as Silk Mori) or Kreink 1/8th ribbon metallic.

We hope you have as much fun stitching this, as we had designing it.





AREA 2: Center green square


STITCH: Basketweave

THREAD: Silk Mori 6086A- 6 stands laid




AREA 4: Medium Purple

STITCH: Diagonal Mosaic- left orientation THREAD: Silk Mori 6106- 5 strands laid

STITCH: Diagonal Mosaic-right orientation THREAD: Silk Mori 6104- 5 strands laid




AREA 6: Menorah

STITCH: Satin Stitch


Tent Stitch Stem Stitch

THREAD: Kreinik #16 5720


Satin Stitch the long horizontal bar




Satin Stitch the base of the menorah, following the shape



Stem Stitch the branches of the Menorah, from one end to the other. Each branch will require 2-3 lines of stem stitch to fill the area.




All remaining open stitches on the center column should be filled with tent stitch




