cell phone embellishments

Cell phones: they're always with us, aren't they? They're an extension of us. We're wearing them, carrying them, using them —why not make them reflect our own personalities by embellishing them with photos, beads, or charms?

Here's how simple and quick it is:

materials needed

- · your cell phone
- 4" x 6" Treasure Tape sheet
- one tube Diamond Beadlets® (clear)
- Mrs. K's Dimensional Threads—variety of colors
- pan or tray to catch the beads

instructions for embellishment

- 1. Make sure your cell phone is clean and free of dust first. Decorate the back of your phone where there is the largest free space.
- 2. Print a favorite photo reduced in size to fit onto your phone
- 3. Cut this same size piece of Treasure Tape and adhere it to the back of your phone. Remove it's red liner to expose sticky tape. Lay your photo right on top of this tape.
- 4. Cut another piece of Treasure Tape the same size as your photo, and lay on top of your photo. Remove its red liner to expose the sticky part.
- 5. Embellish lines and images in your photo with Mrs. K's Dimensional Threads. Press the thread firmly into the image.
- 6. Lay the phone, back side up, in the pan and cover with Diamond Beadlets®. Make sure all sticky areas are now covered. Shake the phone to dislodge loose beads.
