
## Easter the Cat Scrapbook Page by Amy Law



## Materials:

- $\bullet\,$  Mrs. K's dimensional threads- 008c 1/8'' ribbon, 015 #12 braid, 3215 and 032 #16 braid
- plaid paper- P-035 Holly & Plaid by Bisous
- grass paper- 7002 Barn & Field, Jonah Sutherland Collection
- Plain green paper, White Cardstock
- green cardstock in two coordinating colors (scrap pack)
- Font- Font Diner
- flower eyelets-Treasured Memories Mem 2125
- green brads- Scrap Arts
- Treasure Tape 1" roll
- (Treasure Tape dots) optional
- Fiskars paper edgers- wide scallop

## Thread border pattern:

I. Lay down your tape. Peel off red liner.

2. Lay down your 008C Ribbon along both edges of the tape. This is your outside border.

3. Along the inside edges of both 008C pieces, lay down a length of 032.

4. Use your 3215 and make a rounded "zigzag" that

crosses from side to side along the length of your tape. Do the same starting on the opposite side, so that your "zigzags" cross each other and make pointed ovals.

5. Inside each of your ovals, zigzag the 015 so that it loosely covers the shape.

6. Cover your design with the red liner you removed at the beginning. Using it to protect the tape, press down along the length of your design to make sure all your threads are secure.

7. Remove the red liner and place your design in a tray or ziploc bag and pour beads over the exposed tape areas. Tap to remove excess beadlets.
