

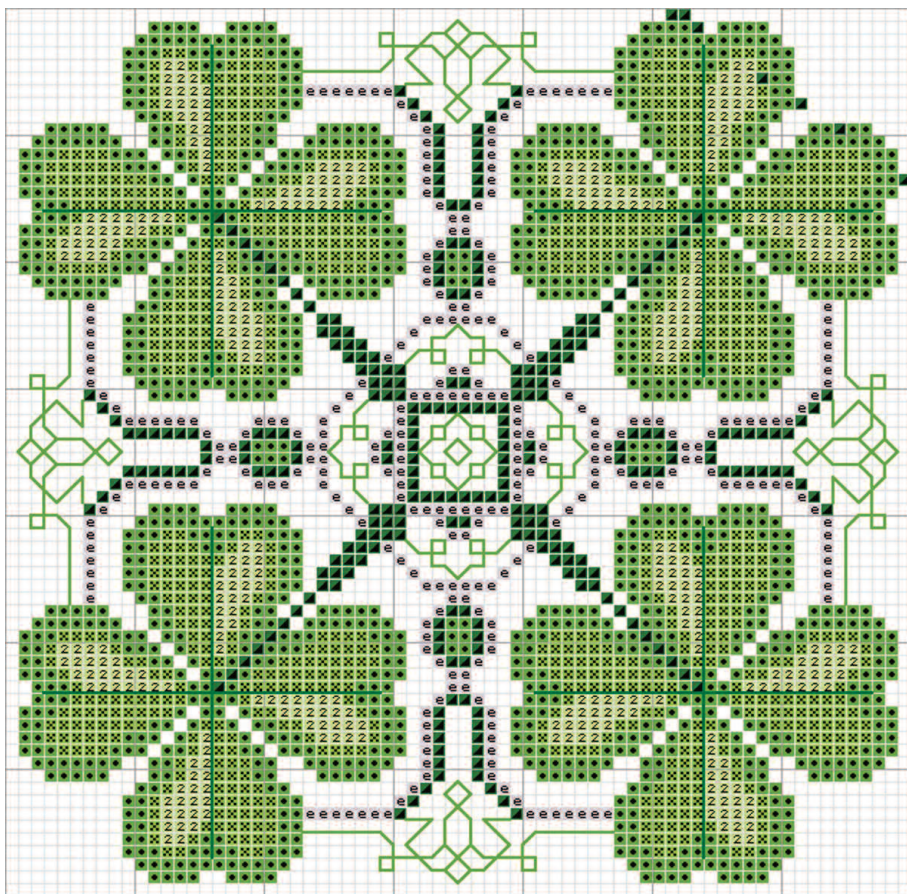
FAITH, HOPE, LOVE, AND LUCK

Materials needed:

- 28-count linen in natural brown color
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid: 015, 5982, 001
- DMC embroidery floss: 3348, 469
- #24 Tapestry needle

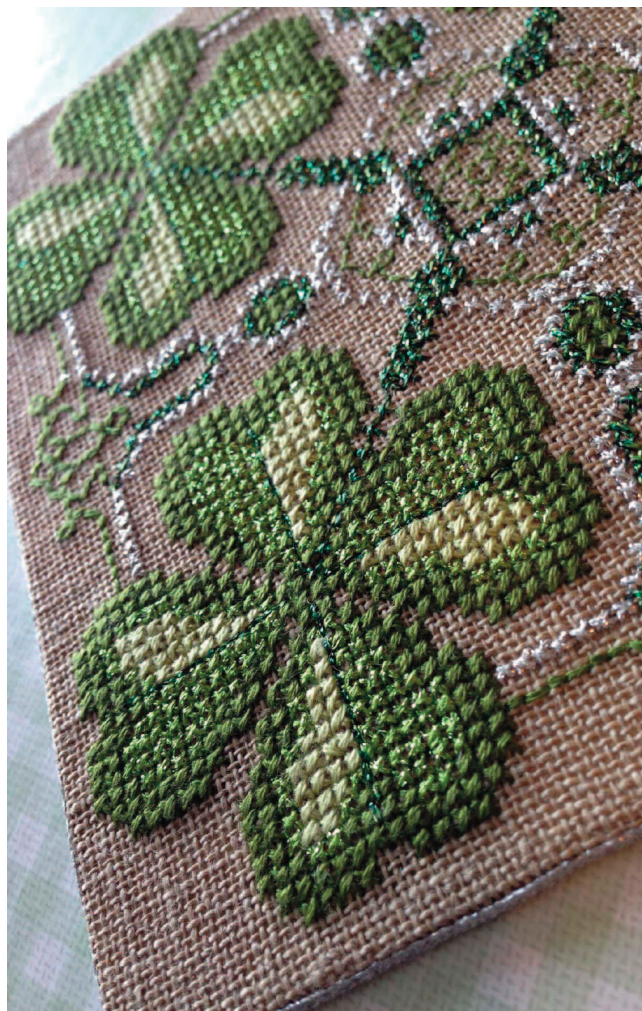


COLOR KEY

- ☞ DMC 3348 Lt. Yellow-Green in cross stitch
- ⊠ Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid 015 Chartreuse in cross stitch
- DMC 469 Avocado Green in cross stitch
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid 5982 Forest Green in cross stitch
- ⦿ Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid 001 Silver in cross stitch
- DMC 469 Avocado Green in backstitch
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid 5982 Forest Green in backstitch

INSTRUCTIONS

This designed is stitched over two thread on the 28-count linen. Each square on the chart equals two fabric threads. Use two strands of floss or one strand of Braid for cross stitching, following the color key. Use one strand of floss or Braid for backstitching according to the color key.
