Flowers Everywhere Card

MATERIALS NEEDED*

• "Little Layers" stamp set by Stampin' Up, or something similar

• Stamp pads: aqua blue, black, and light green

- 4" x 6" Treasure Tape[™] sheet
- Kreinik #12 Braid 014HL Sky Blue Hi Lustre, 015 Chartreuse
- Diamond Beadlets®
- Flat-backed oval cabochons
- StampinWrite markers by Stampin' Up, or other magic markers
- pink cardstock folded to be a 5.5" x 4.25" horizontal card
- white cardstock, cut 1/4" smaller than the size of your card

INSTRUCTIONS*

1. Use a background stamp and the aqua and green stamp pads to create blocks of color here and there on your white cardstock. Vary the shades, making some lighter.

2. Using black ink, stamp flowers randomly on the card.

3. Using the magic markers, color in the flowers.

4. Cut three to four 1-inch squares of Treasure Tape, and place on the card. Place some on top of the flower images.

5. Remove the red liner from the tape squares. If the tape is covering a flower, attach the cabochons to replicate flower centers or petals. On other squares, use the colors of #12 Braid to make curly q-s, borders, or other designs.

6. When embellishing is complete, place your white cardstock in a shallow pan or tray and cover all remaining sticky areas with Diamond Beadlets®.

7. Using leftover scraps of double-sided Treasure Tape[™], center and attach white cardstock to the front of your pink card.
