

RUBBER-STAMPED CARD TO MAKE:

## Friends Make Life a little sweeter

Designed by Dena Lenham

Design Size: 5.5" x 4.25"

A handmade card can be created in seconds with quick embellishments like iron-on thread.

## Materials:

- Kreinik Iron-on #16 Braid 6130 Red
- Kreinik #12 Braid 332 Candy Cane
- Kreinik Teflon Press Cloth
- Mini Iron or household iron
- white cardstock
- Spring Garden floral stamp set by Stampin Up (or similar floral stamps)
- red ink pad
- green ink pad
- sharp needle with a large eye

## Instructions:

- 1. Turn your iron onto the highest heat setting and allow it to heat thoroughly.
- 2. Fold your card stock to be a 5.5" x 4.25" card.
- 3. On the front of the card, along the bottom, use your stem stamp and green ink pad to print a row of flower stems.
- 4. Above the stems, randomly stamp flowers using your flower stamp and red ink pad.
- 5. Lay the red iron-on braid onto your first flower, cover with a Teflon press cloth, and press with your iron for several seconds or until the thread adheres. Iron the thread in a swirl/circle, then trim when you get to the end. Continue this

way, decorating each flower with the red iron-on thread. The Teflon press cloth will keep the adhesive in the thread from sticking to your iron

- 6. On your home computer, print the statement "Friends make life a little sweeter" in your favorite font, in red ink. Trim to a 1" x 5" piece, and glue to the top half of your card
- 7. Make a bow on the right side of your saying: Take an 18-inch piece of #12 Braid in 332 color in your needle and bring both ends up from the inside of your card to the front of the card, in separate holes. Tie the ends into a bow, and trim thread as desired.
