Design size: about 2 3/8" x 2 3/8"


Materials needed:

- Kreinik Fine #8 Braid in 3202, 003, 008HL
- 14-count perforated paper in soft white and in gold
- DMC embroidery floss in 826, 946, 967, 3821, 3828, 310
- Kreinik Treasure Tape double-sided adhesive, or Beacon™ Fabri-Tac™ Permanent Adhesive
- 1" gold pin back (if finishing as a pin)
- scissors
- #24 Tapestry needle

Instructions:

Each square on the chart equals one fabric thread.

- 1. Center and stitch angel on white 14count perforated paper following the color kev.
- Use two strands for cross stitching
- Using one strand for backstitching
- 2. Using scissors, trim around edges of stitched angel, leaving a one square border of perforated paper all around.
- Glue wrong stitched side of 14-count soft white perforated paper to white side of matching 14-count gold perforated paper. Trim edges to match stitched piece when dry.
- Glue 1" pin back to center of back of pin. Let dry.

- Fine #8 Braid 3202 Cat's Eye
- Fine #8 Braid 003 Red
- Fine #8 Braid 008HL Green Hi Lustre
- DMC 826 Md. Blue
- DMC 946 Md. Burnt Orange
- DMC 967 Vy Lt Apricot
- DMC 3821 Straw
- DMC 3828 Hazel Nut Brown
- DMC 310 Black in backstitch
- Fine #8 Braid 3202 in backstitch
- Fine #8 Braid 008HL in backstitch

Alternate finishing: make into a magnet, or attach felt on the back to make as an ornament. Use a a doorknob hanger, use on a scrapbook page, or attach to a photo frame as embellishment.



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
