Iron-on Snow Cards

With Kreinik iron- on threads in color 6010 Pearl, you can add snowy effects to any papercraft project instantly, quickly, effortlessly. It transforms plain Christmas cards, for instance, into boutique-style stationery with the look of embroidery. With the fusible thread, no sewing or embroidery skills are necessary, and it takes just minutes to decorate a handful of cards. Sounds like a great project for a December night!

Materials needed:

- Snow- themed Christmas Cards (pick ones without a glossy finish)
- · Kreinik Iron- on Medium #16 Braid color 6010 Pearl
- · Kreinik 1/8" Ribbon color 6010 Pearl
- Kreinik Adhesive Press Cloth*
- · Mini Craft Iron or household iron
- · ironing surface (we use a mousepad)

* Some household irons are Teflon® coated, but many craft irons are not. We recommend adding this adhesive press cloth to the plate to keep the iron surface clean. Attach the press cloth before turning on the iron.

Instructions:

1. Turn your iron onto the highest heat setting and let it heat thoroughly.

2. Begin ironing the Medium Braid in place to replicate snow drifts, like we did on our model, or in any desired pattern: lay the thread at a starting point, press with your hot iron for several seconds until the thread adheres. If the thread isn't adhering, press longer, or make sure your iron is set to "high heat." Continue working your design this way, as desired.

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
