## **Pink Paper Heart Card**

A Kreinik website design by Amy Law Skill Level: Beginner Design Size: 4 1/2" by 5 1/2"

Combine rubber stamping with iron-on (fusible) threads to embellish a one-of-a-kind Valentine's Day card (for the extra special someone).

## **MATERIALS:**

- Pink and White Cardstock
- Red Texture card- Paper Reflections Note Cards
- Berol Prismacolor Pencils: PC 926 Carmine Red, PC929 Rose, PC 930 Magenta, PC1014 Deco Pink
- Heart Stamp: Rubber Stampede No. A2009E outline Heart
- Rubber Stampede Crystal Dye-Base Ink Pad No. 14508-02 Burgundy
- Kreinik Iron-on #16 Braid in 6100 Carnation
- Kreinik Iron-on 1/8" Ribbon in 6130 Red
- Household Iron or Mini Iron
- Kreinik Teflon Press Cloth

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Stamp your heart onto a piece of white cardstock. Let the ink dry.
- 2. With your iron, embellish the heart pattern with your threads. The outer edge and inner borders of this stamp make easy guides for you to follow with the Iron-ons. Trim the ends of your thread when finished.
- 3. Using the colored pencils, color in the rest of your heart.
- 4. Cut out your design, following the outside edge of the heart as closely as possible.
- 5. Cut two pieces of cardstock, one pink and one red, and mount the smaller one onto the larger one.
- 6. Using the Iron-ons, make a swirl design on the cardstock. Trim your ends.
- 7. Mount your decorated heart on the cardstock wherever you wish. Then mount the whole design on the front of your note card. Your card is finished!
