

**Skill Level:** Beginner • Design size: Finishes at about 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"

## Materials needed:

- Tokens & Trifles<sup>™</sup> white eyelet heart sewing card (20-count perforated paper)
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid color 421 Azalea and 713 Pink Mauve
- small heart shaped rubber stamp
- stamp pad with pink ink

## **Instructions:**


- 1. Rubber stamp the heart image with the pink ink in the center of the heart-shaped token. Allow it to dry completely.
- 2. Cross stitch on the perforated paper heart using one strand of Braid following the color key and chart.
- 3. When stitching is complete, sew the backer card to the back of your stitched heart by backstitching in the decorative border area using the red or pink Braid.

## Finishing:

Use glue or double-sided tape to attach to a greeting card—or attach on a painted paper-mache box for a valentine candy dish.
