Stitched in silk threads on perforated paper, like ornaments of yore, this little project can decorate a tree, decknob, or any spot that needs a little merriment. Do you suppose the deer are happy it's Christmastime?


Materials needed:

- 14-count perforated paper in Anniversary Gold (Wichelt Imports)
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid in 002V Vintage Gold
- one 2.5m skein each Kreinik Silk Mori® in 0434, 4167, 7135
- #24 Tapestry needle

For finishing, we used:


- ArtMinds metal sign, 3" x 6" (from Michaels Arts & Crafts Store)
- Celebrate ItTM "Be Merry" magnet (from Michaels Arts & Crafts Store)
- Kreinik 1/4" double-sided tape





Color Keu:

Silk Mori 7135
Silk Mori 0434
Silk Mori 4167
#4 Braid 002V



Instructions:

Cross Stitch this design centered on your perforated paper using two strands of Silk Mori or one strand of Very Fine #4 Braid according to the color key.

Finishing Instructions:

To finish as we did, carefully trim the stitched design (leave at least three rows of blank paper between the stitching area and your cutting line) to fit onto the ArtMinds sign. Attach several rows of double sided tape to your sign; remove the red liner to expose the top sticky area. Press your stitched design onto the tape, making sure there are no bubbles or wrinkles. Add the "Be Merry" magnet on top.
