Wedding Scrapbook Photos

Recreate the lacy, dressy style of your own wedding on your scrapbook page by decorating borders on your photos. It's easy and simple to do using red liner double-sided tape and metallic braid. The look is just beautiful, and transforms your wedding memories into 3-dimensional beauty.

Materials needed:

- wedding photos
- 1/4" Treasure Tape™
- Diamond Beadlets®
- Kreinik Tapestry #12 Braid in 032
- Pearl and 101 Platinum
- shallow pan or tray

Instructions:

You can either mount your photos onto your scrapbook paper first and then decorate, or mount your photos onto a slightly larger piece of cardstock, decorate, and then mount on your scrapbook paper.

1. Lay a strip of 1/4" Treasure Tape all along the outside edge of your photo.

2. Peel back the red liner to expose the sticky top.

3. Lay the Tapestry #12 Braid 032 Pearl and 101 Platinum in swirls, wavy lines, or similar style, on the tape, pressing the thread to make sure it adheres.

4. When thread decorating is complete, lay your photo in the shallow pan or tray and cover all remaining sticky areas with Diamond Beadlets®.
