
Kreinik Silvery Stitches

Materials needed:

- Tokens & Trifles™ Trinkets™ Hornbook (white 18-count perforated paper shape)
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid in color 014HL Sky Blue Hi Lustre
- Kreinik Very Fine #4 Braid in color 001 Silver
- Kreinik Japan #5 in color 170J Natural Pewter
- #26 Tapestry needle
- purchased snowflake ornament frame (we found ours at Michaels Arts & Crafts Store)
- Optional: small flat-backed cabochons or silver beads

Instructions:

1. If your ornament frame has a clear plastic insert, use that as a template to trace your circle area onto the Hornbook perforated paper shape. This will ensure that your stitching stays within the area allowed by your ornament frame. You may need to add or subtract stitches from the design to make it fit within the circle.

- 2. Begin stitching the design centered in the traced circle of your perforated paper. Use one strand of Braid for cross stitches (see the color key for guide), or one strand of Japan thread for the backstitches (dark gray lines on the chart).
- 3. If desired, add flat-backed cabochons (glue or double-sided tape) or beads in white spaces.
- 4. When stitching/beading is complete, trim to fit inside your frame, then insert.

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
