

Snow Sisters

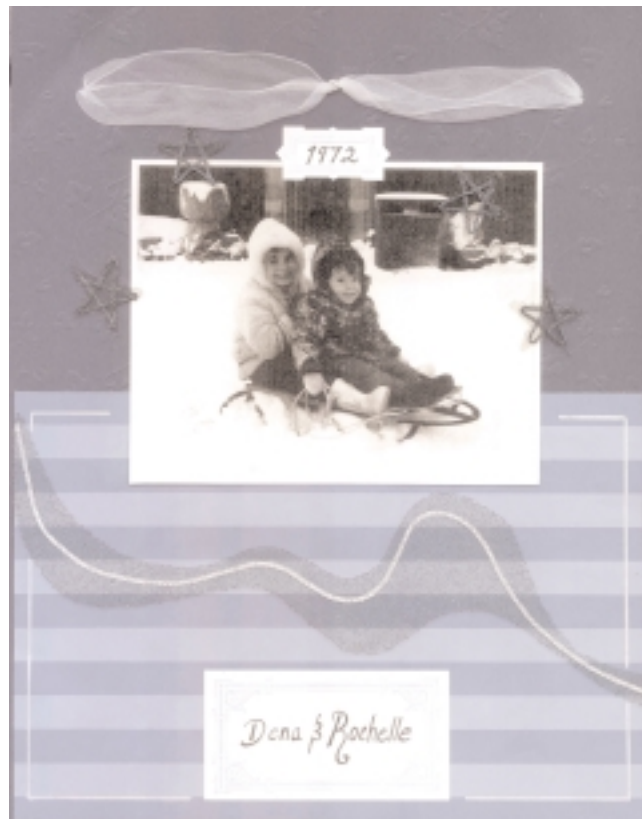
SCRAPBOOK PAGE BY AMY LAW

Materials needed:

- 8.5" x 11" Treasure It Tape Sheet
- Treasure It star shapes
- Kreinik 1/8" Ribbon 3231 Moonstone
- Kreinik Fine #8 Braid 225C Slate
- Diamond Beadlets®
- White organdy ribbon
- round hole punch
- Silver pen
- Black pen
- White cardstock scraps
- 8 1/2" x 11" navy or slate blue cardstock (we chose one with a barely noticeable, subtle background pattern)
- 8 1/2" x 5" blue striped paper
- Black and white picture, with a snow theme
- Rubber stamp of a decorative border or frame
- light blue ink pad
- shallow tray or pan
- scissors, or Fiskars non-stick scissors

Instructions:

- 1 Using your favorite gluing method, adhere the striped paper to the lower half of the blue cardstock. Center your photo on the top half of the page, and adhere.
- 2 With your scraps of white cardstock, rubber stamp, and light blue ink, stamp one piece to use as the date marker, and one to use as the title block. Write the date of the photo in the small block using your black ink. Write your page title, or the names of the people in the photo as we've done, on the larger white card. Adhere white card at bottom of page, adhere date card just above photo.
- 3 Peel the small stars off the Treasure Tape star sheet and adhere on and around the photo. Working one star at a time, remove the red liner, and trace a star pattern using the Fine #8 Braid 225C thread. Complete each star in this manner, pressing each thread to make sure it adheres.
- 4 Place the page in your shallow tray, and pour Diamond Beadlets over remaining sticky areas of stars. Swirl your fingertips over the areas to secure



beads. Tap page to dislodge any loose beads.

5 Cut a swirl shape from edge to edge across the bottom of the large sheet of Treasure Tape. You may want to experiment on a blank piece of white paper to make a 'template' of your swirl. You can use this as a guide in cutting the shape from the tape.

6 Remove the white backing from the tape and adhere tape to your scrapbook page, under the photo. The tape should lay edge to edge, horizontally across your page.

7 Remove red liner from tape, and lay 1/8" Ribbon in 3231 in a pattern across the swirl. This will give an undulating, subtle touch to your page, resembling the path of a sled down a snowy hill.

8 When finished with the ribbon, place the page in your pan and cover remaining sticky areas with Diamond Beadlets.

9 With your silver pen, draw a simple line as a border along the edge of the blue striped paper.

10 Punch two holes in the top of your page, and run white organdy ribbon through, simply taping ends on the back. Using a small piece of 1/8" Ribbon 3231, tie a bow or knot in the front center of the white ribbon as a final decoration.
