

Sparkling Spool Snowflake Oranment



What a fun gift for a needlepointed or cross stitcher. While you could start from scratch with wire, Kreinik spools, and jingle bells to shape a snowflake ornament, we cheated a bit: purchased this premade snowflake at Michael's Arts & Crafts store, then repurposed it. The metallic thread adds holiday shimmer and dresses up a classic winter motif. Easy as Christmas Pie.

Materials list:

- Celebrate ItTM Christmas owl wooden spool/bell snowflake ornament from Michael's Arts & Crafts store (From MSPCI, Irving, TX)
- Kreinik 1/4" double-sided red-liner tape
- Kreinik ribbon or braid in Christmas colors (we used 1/8" and 1/16" Ribbons in colors 308, 850, 332, 015, 4503, 008L)



Instructions:

- 1. Remove any twine or thread that may be on the premade ornament's spools (as shown, we removed the brown twine).
- 2. Cover each spool with the red-liner double-sided tape.
- 3. Starting with one spool, remove the red liner tape, then begin to wrap the Kreinik thread around the spool. Press the thread into the tape to secure, and wrap just enough to cover the tape. If needed, dab a bit of glue on the end of the last thread wrap to secure.
- 4. Repeat step #3 for each spool on the ornament.
- 5. Use leftover Kreinik ribbons to make an ornament hanger.
