

Welcome Baby!

A rubber stamped card

Skill Level: all levels

Materials needed:

- 3/4" Treasure Tape
- Diamond Beadlets
- Kreinik #12 Braid in 9300 Orchid
- Kreinik Iron-on Medium Braid in 6500 Hydrangea
- Kreinik Teflon press cloth
- Mini iron or household iron
- flat-backed tiny aqua colored beads
- pink cardstock
- mint green cardstock
- white cardstock
- fancy-edged scissors in a soft wave pattern
- Black ink pad
- Mint green ink pad
- colored pencils
- "Announcements, Brushstroke Alphabet" stamp sets from Stampin Up
- shallow pan or tray

Instructions:

First turn your iron onto the highest heat setting and let it heat thoroughly.

1 Cut the mint green cardstock to 5.5" x 4.25". Cut the pink cardstock to 5.25" x 3.75"—cutting the bottom edge with the fancy-edged scissors. Cut the white cardstock to 5" x 6.75", trimming the top and bottom edge with the fancy-edged scissors. Fold the white cardstock in half.

2 With pieces of Treasure Tape, attach pink cardstock to the mint green, centered. Center and attach the folded white cardstock to the pink in the same way.

3 On the white cardstock, stamp "Welcome Baby!" in green ink, and



stamp teddy bears in black ink. Stamp the row of animals along the bottom edge, as shown in the photo, in black ink.

4 Color the bears and animals with colored pencils.

5 Tie a small piece of Iron-on Braid into a bow, and iron one onto each bear. To do this, lay the bow on the bear, cover with the Teflon press cloth, and press for several seconds with your hot iron.

6 Lay a piece of the Treasure Tape along the animals at the bottom. Remove red liner to expose sticky tape.

7 Attach aqua beads as wheels beneath each animal. Lay the #12 Braid 9300 above the beads, as shown in the photo.

8 Lay the card in your shallow pan or tray and cover remaining sticky areas with Diamond Beadlets.

9 Take a strand of #12 Braid 9300 and tie around the fold of the card as shown, into a bow.
