



# Woven Gift Card Holder

Use a **pin loom** to weave a colorful square that can be sewn into a gift card holder. It's quick, easy and fun. The special touch that makes it Christmas-y: the metallic Kreininik Braid.

## Materials needed:

- Zoom Loom pin loom (makes 4-inch woven squares)
- Any red worsted-weight yarn
- Kreininik Medium #16 Braid in 203 Flame
- Sewing thread to match the yarn
- optional: ribbons for the top and buttons for the center embellishment

## Instructions:

- Following manufacturer's instructions that come with the Zoom Loom, begin weaving a square with the red yarn. Instead of weaving the final layer in yarn, however, weave with the Medium #16 Braid in 203 Flame.
- When weaving is completed, hide thread ends by weaving into the edges of the square.

## Finishing Instructions:

- Fold three points of the square toward the middle. Sew this point together with the sewing thread, then sew each section together to make a closed "envelope." Make sure you don't sew all the way through to the back of the square.
- Add ribbons at the top if desired, or use extra Kreininik Braid to make an ornament hanger.
- Add buttons to the center if desired.
