





Woven Tree Ornament

Use a **pin loom** to weave three squares that can be sewn into a primitive Christmas tree ornament. It's quick, easy and fun. The secret is in the touch of metallic: Kreinik Braid adds that holiday feel. A real-twig base adds the nature touch.



Materials needed:

- Zoom Loom pin loom (makes 4-inch woven squares)
- Any light green worsted-weight yarn
- Kreinik Medium #16 Braid in 008 Green
- Sewing thread to match the yarn
- a piece of twig for the trunk
- optional: ribbons for the top

Instructions:

- Following manufacturer's instructions that come with the Zoom Loom, begin weaving a square with the green yarn. Instead of weaving the final layer in yarn, however, weave with the Medium #16 Braid in green.
- When weaving is completed, hide thread ends by weaving into the edges of the square.
- · Make three.

Finishing Instructions:

- Fold a woven square in half, matching two opposite points. With sewing thread, sew the open sides closed. Repeat with all three squares to make three triangles.
- With sewing thread, sew each triangle together.
- Make an opening in the bottom triangle, insert the twig end, then secure the opening closed with sewing thread.
- Add ribbons at the top if desired, or use extra Kreinik Braid to make an ornament hanger.
