

Using Iron On Threads:

Create fast, elegant embellishments by ironing on thread!



1. Place Teflon sheet over design
2. Heat thread with iron to adhere

Iron-On threads are washable and dry cleanable. They will adhere to any irregular surface including glass, fabric, paper, and wood.



IRON-ON THREAD IDEAS:

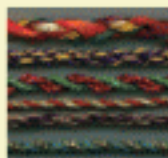
- Easily embellish costumes without any sewing: dress up simple garments or add details to create a "look." You can also topstitch your designs for a more permanent embellishment.
- Create faux Cornelli (decorative sewing and stitching)
- Use stencils with disappearing chalk then apply threads with iron. The chalk disappears leaving the thread design.
 - Embellish banners and signs
 - Decorate glass orbs with Glow-in-the-Dark threads and hang them.
 - Decorate masks for Halloween or theatre.



Cording Drill:

This hand-held tool twists together two or more strands of thread to create custom cording.

CORDING DRILL IDEAS:



- Create corded belts with beads & charms
- Faux Jewelry (bracelets, necklaces, & brooches)
- Decorative cording you can use for: pillows, Christmas stockings, cowboy shirt trim, braid trim for military uniforms, costumes for royalty, and victorian or other era dresses
- Create decorative hair ties to match a dance costume



Fusible Iron-on Gems:

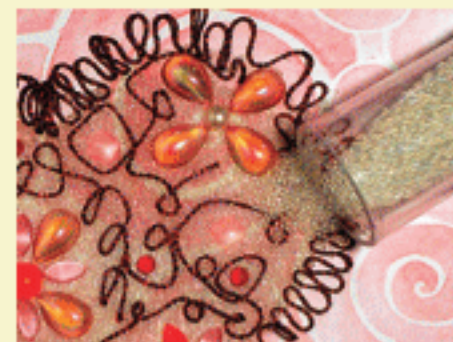
Create fantasy looks with faux gems. These Iron-on embellishments are easy to apply, simply position them and heat using an iron to adhere.


FUSIBLE GEM IDEAS:

- Decorate dresses for a jeweled look
 - Create crowns, bejewel boxes, shoes, and other props
- Easily embellish dance costumes to add sparkle: won't restrict the stretch of leotard fabrics

Using Treasure Tape

Make Washable, Dry-Cleanable,
No-Sew Embellishments!



1. Place double-faced tape over design
2. Embellish with threads
3. Cover remaining tape with beadlets

Once ironed to heat-set them, these designs can be hand washed, washed in a protective bag in the washing machine, or cleaned in a green dry cleaning machine.

TAPE IDEAS FOR THEATRE:

- Apply faux embroidery to costumes with metallic threads and beading
 - Embellish props with filigree, faux jewels, fabric, or ribbons: jars, bottles, walking sticks, books, baskets, clocks, shoes, etc.
 - Decorate props that normally cannot be embellished, with the option of removing the design afterward
 - Quick fixes on torn costumes or ill-fitting costumes

- Hem clothing quickly (skirts, pants)



- Attach fringe or lace to the hem of a dress
- Make clown shoes for older clowns who can't wear decorative bulbous shoes.



- Attaching appliances to skin: First powder skin to dry it. Cover with a fixative spray used for applying beards or mustaches. Then apply the tape and position your fake appendages (such as horns, prosthetics)



- Cover shoes with fake fur for use with animal costumes
- Attach items to clothing: stuffed parrots on your shoulder, a sheriff's star, or military insignias or stars
- Use reflective beads or attach Kreinik's Glow-in-the-Dark threads for visual effects in dark scenes or low lighting
- Embellish masks for fantasy effects!



- Decorate hat bands

- Remove your best designs and store them: You can apply fresh tape to the back and re-use them
- Hang posters or other props: The tape's strength enables hanging of objects in previously impossible places (on metal, glass)



TAPE IDEAS FOR HALLOWEEN:

- Attach fake fur for animal costume
- Attach ears or other appliances to headbands or hats
- Apply reflective strips or use reflective beads on costume's for trick or treating
- Embellish plain masks with beads, ribbons and feathers
- Cover mask base with fabric
- Kid craft-make trick or treat bags from plain gift bags
- Put up party decorations
- Attach yarn inside hats as fake hair
- Cover hats with fabric and beads
- Attach hatbands to hats or create belts for costumes



TAPE IDEAS FOR DANCE:

- Easily change costume embellishment for competitions.
- Decorate tutus without sewing: Use tape to attach embellishments
- Add embellishment to dance shoes to match a costume
- Decorate hair barrettes
- Fast decorations for leotards (place on tape and apply fringe)
