This ornament design can be worked in either a white/gold or green colorway.

## Materials needed:

-18-ct mono canvas in white, 5 " $\times 5$ "

- FOR WHITE VERSION: Kreinik Silk Mri white 8000
- FOR GREEN VERSION: Kreinik Silk Mori green 4036, dark brown 7166
- Kreinik Blending Filament \#002V
- a round ornament frame with 3" opening
- Kreinik Treasure Tape ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ dots


## Instructions:

1. Use 4-ply of Silk Mori, or 4 strands of Blending Filament following the dagrams. Use green silk for the tree, brown silk for the trunk, and gold Blending Filament for the remainder.
2. When stitching is complete, make a "sandwich" by layering the front of the gold ornament frame on top, followed by your stitched piece, and the gold ornament frame backer. Use Treasure Tape ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ double-sided tape dots as the adhesive between layers. Add ribbons etc for ornament hanger as desired.

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The white tree is worked in 4ply Silk Mori \#800A including the tree trunk.
The greeb tree is worked in 4ply Silk Mori \#4036, the tree trunk in 4ply 8050 brown.
The stars and outline is worked in 4 strands of gold fillament \#002V.
The canvas is 18 ct mono.

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
