

Season's Greetings Gift Bag

Materials needed:

- Medium-sized white craft bag with handles
- Kreinik 1/8" Iron-on Ribbon 6350 Green and 6225 Gold
- Household iron or Clover Mini Iron*
- 3" x 4" Teflon Press Cloth*
- 8.5" x 11" Red Cardstock (or size to fit your bag)
- Scrap pieces of white and red cardstock to use as the gift tag
- 8" x 10" sheet of double-stick Treasure Tape™
- Gold, red, and green Wraphia™ (ours was made by Berwick Industries)
- Rubber stamps used: Season's Greetings by JRL Design, small ornament
- Gold pigment ink
- Gold embossing Powder
- Rhinestuds from BeJeweler™



****These items are found in the Iron On Starter Set.***

Instructions for Bag:

1. Cut red cardstock to fit the front of the gift bag. Cut a smaller piece to fit the gift tag.
2. Turn on your iron to the highest heat setting and allow it to heat thoroughly. Cut green Iron-on Ribbon into various lengths, such as 2 inches up to 4 inches. Place threads one at a time onto your bag, cover with the Teflon Press Cloth, and press for 10 to 15 seconds or until the thread adheres.
3. Continue this way until you have created the green 'branches' of your tree.
4. Using the gold Iron-on Ribbon in the same manner, fold the thread back and forth randomly to make a tree trunk.
5. Using a variety of size and color, randomly place Rhinestuds between the 'branches' of your tree. If you use the Rhinestuds by BeJeweler™ as we did, you will need to cover the studs with the Teflon press cloth, and press without moving the iron. The heat-sensitive backing will affix the jewel. Allow to cool.
6. Stamp "Season's Greetings" with gold ink and emboss with gold embossing powder.
7. Cut Treasure Tape™ sheet to fit the red cardstock. Remove the white liner from the tape, and apply to the back of your cardstock, smoothing out the tape as you lay it to avoid getting bubbles.
8. Remove the red liner from the tape on your large piece of red cardstock to expose the sticky side, then adhere the red paper to your bag.

Instructions for tag:

1. Cut a small piece of white cardstock scrap to make a gift tag. Cut a small piece of red cardstock to fit the gift tag.
2. Cut Treasure Tape™ sheet to fit the red cardstock you just cut. Remove the white liner from the tape, and apply to the back of your cardstock.
3. Remove the red liner from the tape on your red cardstock to expose the sticky side, then adhere the red paper to your white gift tag.
4. Use the ornament stamp, gold ink, and gold embossing powder to add a decorative touch to the red side.
5. Punch a hole in the top and attach with Wraphia to your bag.
