

Lovely Little Lunchbox

Use this as a container for a heart-felt gift of cookies or chocolates

MATERIALS:

- Tin lunchbox (Michaels Stores)
- Decorative Paper (Sizzix Little Sizzles Classics- red blocks, gold stars)
- Card stock in coordinating colors
- Rubber Stampede Stamp No. A2009E Outline Heart
- Rubber Stampede Crystal Dye-Base Ink Pad No. 14508-02 Burgundy
- Treasure Tape™ 4x6 sheet
- Treasure Tape Shapes- Hearts
- Diamond Beadlets®
- Mrs. K's Dimensional Thread in colors that match your paper: we used 321J Dark Japan Gold and 003V Vintage Red



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut your background paper to fit your lunchbox. Peel back the white liner on your Treasure Tape™ sheet and place your paper printed-side-down on the sticky surface of the tape. Replace the white liner and smooth out any air pockets with your fingers if necessary. Cut out your paper. Repeat this process (this time placing the paper back-side-down) to apply tape to the back of your paper also.
2. Peel the white liner from your second sheet of Treasure Tape™. Stamp a heart shape onto the sticky surface of the tape with your stamp. Replace the liner and cut out your heart. Remove the white liner again and apply the heart to another piece of decorated paper. Cut out the heart. Apply the some of the heart Tape Shapes to your remaining paper. Cut them out.
3. Peel back the pink liner from the tape on the FRONT of your background paper. (Use the liner to cover portions of the image while you work, so that your hands do not stick.) Place your heart shapes on the back-ground wherever you want them.
4. Using your Dimensional Threads, embellish the background around your hearts. Next peel the tape from your hearts, one at a time, and embellish them also.
5. When you are done decorating, place your paper design in a tray or container and pour Diamond Beadlets® over the tape. Swirl gently with your fingers to cover all areas. Tap to remove excess beadlets.
6. Peel back one corner of the liner on the back of your design. Position the design on your lunchbox and press down the corner to hold it in place. Peel the rest of the liner off and press down firmly to adhere the entire design. Your lunchbox is ready to use!
