

THREAD AND STITCH GUIDE FOR Patty Paints - H018 Pumpkin

SUGGESTED THREAD LIST

1 skein Impressions 020

1 reel Kreinik 1/16" Ribbon 026L

1 reel Kreinik Medium (#16) Braid 9194

1 reel Kreinik Tapestry (#12) Braid 007L

1 reel Kreinik Tapestry (#12) Braid 015L 1 reel Kreinik Very Fine (#4) Braid 9194

1 skein Watercolours 000

STITCHING INSTRUCTIONS

1. The green and beige dividing lines on the pumpkin are worked in the Tent stitch. Use 1 strand of Kreinik Tapestry (#12) Braid 015L for the green and 1 strand of Kreinik Tapestry (#12) Braid 007L for the beige.

The purple circles are worked in the Nobuko stitch. Use 1 strand of Kreinik 1/16" Ribbon 026L.


The cream area of the pumpkin is worked in the Parisian stitch. Use 1 strand of Watercolours 000.


The dark green area of the pumpkin stem is worked in the Alternating Smyrna Cross. Use 1 strand of Kreinik Tapestry (#12) Braid 015L.


The light green portion of the stem is worked in the Diagonal Mosaic stitch. Use 1 strand of Kreinik Medium (#16) Braid 9194.

The background is worked in the Hungarian stitch. Use 1 strand of Impressions 020.


The green curly tendril is couched. Lay 1 strand of Kreinik Medium (#16) Braid 9194 over the area and couch into place with 1 strand of Kreinik Very Fine (#4) Braid 9194.


