

Photo Embellishment

With this technique, you can decorate all or part of your photo. You can even make your own “photo sticker”!

MATERIALS:

- Your photo, or a copy
- Treasure Tape 4x6 sheet
- 1/8" Roll of Treasure Trim
- Diamond Beadlets®
- Mrs. K's Dimensional Thread in colors that match
- your photo

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Embellishing your entire photo is very easy. Peel back the white liner on your Treasure Tape sheet and place your photo face down on the sticky surface of the tape. Replace the white liner and smooth out any air pockets with your fingers if necessary. Cut out your photo.

2. Peel back the pink liner from the tape. (Use the liner to cover portions of the image while you work, so that your hands do not stick.) Embellish any part of your photo- from clothes to objects to the landscape!

3. Place your photo in a tray or container and pour Diamond Beadlets® over the tape. Swirl gently with your fingers to cover all areas. Tap to remove excess beadlets, and your photo is finished!

OR

1. To embellish only certain parts of your photo, you will first need to trace the shape(s) of those areas onto your tape. You can use a lightbox if you have one, or just hold your photo up to a sunny window. Place the tape sheet over your photo, red liner side up, over your light source. With a ball point pen, trace the shape you wish to embellish. Press firmly to make a good impression.

2. Cut out the shape you have traced on the tape. Peel off the white liner and carefully apply the tape shape to the matching area on your photo.

3. Peel off the red liner and begin embellishing.

4. Place your photo in a tray or container and pour Diamond Beadlets® over the tape. Swirl gently with your fingers to cover all areas. Tap to remove excess beadlets, and your photo is finished!

TO MAKE A PHOTO STICKER:

Peel the red liner off another sheet of Treasure Tape™ . Place your embellished photo, decorated side UP, on the tape. Replace the liner and cut out the edges of your photo OR cut out just one figure or shape (see example). You now have a “sticker” that you can place anywhere. Simply peel off the backer to adhere it to any surface.
