This design uses glow-in-the-dark colors of Kreinik Threads, which can be found in craft stores, specialty cross stitch shops, internet sources and mail order. Expose the fluorescent colors to light and they will emit a soft glow for up to 15 minutes (*note: they should not be used for safety-rated reflective material*). This project makes a fun Halloween bag for you or your child.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Kreinik Very Fine (#4) Braid™ in 051F Tangerine, 053F Lime, 054F Lemon-Lime, 055F Watermelon, 012 Purple
- Kreinik Blending Filament™ 053F Lime
- Cotton embroidery floss as listed in color key
- Charles Craft 15" x 17" Tote Bag in Natural color with a 14-count stitching area
- #24 Tapestry needle

INSTRUCTIONS:

Cross stitch this design over one thread on the 14-count Aida cloth area of Charles Craft's tote bag. Use two strands of cotton embroidery floss or one strand of Very Fine (#4) Braid according to the color key. In areas where cotton floss and Blending Filament are combined, used two strands of floss with one strand of Blending Filament.

- 2 Very Fine Braid 051F Tangerine
- + Very Fine Braid 053F Lime
- / Very Fine Braid 054F Lemon-Lime
- T Very Fine Braid 055F Watermelon
- Backstitching with one strand 3371/382 for pumpkins, faces, letters, leaves
- Straight stitch stars with one strand Very Fine Braid 012
