



RUBBER-STAMPED CARD:

VALENTINE LOVE

Designed by Dena Lenham

Design Size: 4.25" x 5.5"

Skill Level: beginner

Materials:

- Kreinik Iron-on #16 Braid 6130 Red
- Kreinik #12 Braid 100 White
- Kreinik Teflon Press Cloth
- Mini Iron or household iron
- white cardstock
- red cardstock
- Treasure Tape™ heart shapes
- Diamond Beadlets®
- Mini heart and dot stamp (we used Beyond the Basics stamp set by Stampin Up)
- red ink pad
- shallow pan or tray

Instructions:

1. Turn your iron onto the highest heat setting and allow it to heat thoroughly.
2. Fold your white cardstock to become a 4.25" x 5.5" card.
3. If needed, sketch the word "love" in the lower left corner of your card front with a light pencil. Use our photo as a guide for placement. Then lay the red iron-on braid at base of the first letter, cover with the Teflon press cloth, and press with your iron for several seconds or until the thread adheres. Continue ironing the letters, working one thread section at a time. The Teflon will keep the adhesive in the thread from sticking to the iron.
4. Take your stamp and randomly print hearts and dots in a swirling motion from the bottom right side of the card up to the top.
5. Remove a large heart from the Treasure Tape™ heart sheet and place on your red cardstock. Cut out this heart. Peel back the tape's red liner, and attach the heart to your card, in the upper right side.
6. Place another Treasure Tape™ heart shape directly on top of this heart, and peel back the tape's red liner. Decorate with the white #12 Braid, making swirls or curly q's.
7. When thread decorating is complete, place the card in a shallow tray and cover the sticky heart shape with Diamond Beadlets®. Swirl your fingertips on the heart to make sure beads fully cover the area. Tap card on side to dislodge any loose beads.
