

Veterans Day appreciation card

Made with Kreinik Iron-on Threads – no glue, no glitter, no mess!

Materials needed:

- Mrs. K's Iron-on #16 Braid in 6450 Royal Blue
- Mrs. K's Iron-on Ribbon in 6130 Red
- Kreinik Teflon Press Cloth
- Household iron or our Mini Iron
- White cardstock

Instructions:

- Print the template on white cardstock. You will find two cards on this one sheet, so cut the sheet into two cards.
- Turn your iron onto the highest heat setting. Allow it to heat thoroughly
- For the flag card, use Iron-on Braid in Royal Blue to make the "x" representing stars. Lay the thread on your card, cover with the Teflon press cloth to keep the adhesive in the thread from sticking to your iron, and press for three to five seconds. Continue in this way, cutting the thread when you reach the end of each "x" area, and starting on the next one.
- Use the Iron-on Ribbon in Red in the same way to make the red waves of the flag.
- For the star card, lay and iron each color of iron-on thread following the star shapes on the template. Fold the thread over on itself as you come to each corner.

Tip: We buy a box of 500 white envelopes from an office supply store to keep on hand for these quick-and-easy cards.

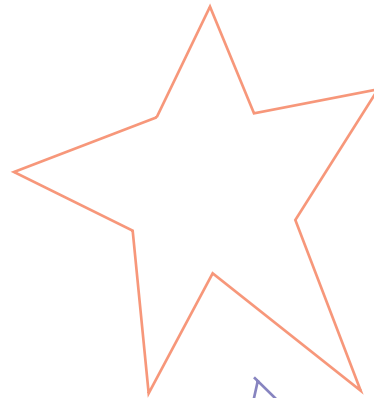
